AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
 THE PARKING AND OPERATION OF VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE
 STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS
 Approved October 21, 1924

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Parking and Operation of Vehicles and the Use of the Streets within the City of Urbana, Illinois" approved October 21, 1924 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 5-K thereto:

Section 5-K. Whenever any traffic ^{sign}/~~signal~~, or stop sign has heretofore, is, or may hereafter be installed on the streets of this City, by order, authority, or resolution ~~adopted by~~ the City Council of this City, the driver of a vehicle approaching such sign shall obey the command or order contained on such sign and where stop signs have heretofore or may hereafter be erected at street intersections on order of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the driver of a vehicle approaching any such stop sign shall bring his vehicle to a complete stop before entering such intersection.
