

AN ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AS AMENDED, TO RELOCATE A PORTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE LIQUOR ZONE IN SAID CITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That "An Ordinance Regulating the Sale at Retail of Alcoholic Liquors Within the City of Urbana, Illinois", as adopted and approved May 17, 1954, and as amended by ordinance adopted June 6, 1955, be amended as follows:

In Section 11 of said ordinance, as amended, strike the portion as follows:

"Thence in an Easterly direction along the center line of the Boneyard Ditch a distance of One Hundred Fifty Feet (150'); thence North to the center line of University Avenue;"

And substitute provisions as follows:

"Thence in an Easterly direction along the center line of the Boneyard Ditch a distance of Three Hundred Twenty-Five Feet (325'); thence North to the center line of University Avenue; thence in a Westerly direction along the center line of University Avenue to a point located in the center line of University Avenue located One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') East of the East line of Cunningham Avenue measured from the intersection of Cunningham Avenue and University Avenue;"
