URBANA CITY COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 1997

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in regular session at 7:30 p.m., Monday, February 3, 1997 at the Urbana School District Office at 205 North Race Street.
