# URBANA CITY COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY, APRIL 7, 1997

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in regular session at 7:30 p.m., Monday, April 7, 1997 at the Urbana School District Office at 205 North Race Street.

Present at the meeting were Members of the Council:

There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Mayor Tod Satterthwaite. Mayor Satterthwaite stated that Alderman Hayes would be absent from the meeting this evening due to surgery he had over the weekend.

#### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Alderwoman Ryan moved approval of the minutes of the March 17, 1997 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Kearns and carried by a voice vote.

## ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mayor Satterthwaite requested that Approval of a House Moving Permit for 2604 S. Philo Road be added to the agenda as item number seven under New Business.

Alderman Pollock requested that the item be added as the first item of business under New Business. There were no objections.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Satterthwaite stated that the first item of New Business is a <u>House Moving Permit for 2604 South Philo Road</u>.

Assistant Director of Public Works Glenn Berman was present to answer Council questions.

Alderman Taylor moved to authorize the Director of Public Works to issue a <u>House Moving Permit for 2604 South Philo</u>

Road. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Ryan and carried by a voice vote.

Kim Gerstein presented the staff report on <u>An Amendment</u>

To A Part Of The Zoning Ordinance And Zoning Map Of The City Of

<u>Urbana, Illinois (604-702½ E. Main, Plan Case No. 1646-M-97)</u> and <u>An Amendment To The Comprehensive Plan Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (604-702½ E. Main, Plan Case No. 1646-CP-97)</u>. Staff has requested that both of these cases be deferred until April 14 for Committee discussion and April 21 Council for action.

Alderman Pollock moved to defer An Amendment To A Part

Of The Zoning Ordinance And Zoning Map Of The City Of Urbana,

Illinois (604-702½ E. Main, Plan Case No. 1646-M-97) and An

Amendment To The Comprehensive Plan Map Of The City Of Urbana,

Illinois (604-702½ E. Main, Plan Case No. 1646-CP-97). The

motion was seconded by Alderman Whelan.

Both of these cases were deferred to the City Council meeting on April 21, 1997 and will be on the agenda of the Committee on Administration & Finance, April 14, 1997 for discussion.

Mayor Satterthwaite presented An Amendment To A Part

Of The Zoning Ordinance And Zoning Map Of The City Of Urbana,

Illinois (Poplar-Water Area Of East Main Street/Railroad

Residential Area, Plan Case No. 1648-M-97) and An Amendment To

The Comprehensive Plan Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (Poplar-Water Area Of East Main Street/Railroad Residential Area, Plan

Case 1648-CP-97) for Council consideration. Staff requests that these items be deferred.

Alderwoman Patt moved to direct staff to consolidate
Plan Case No. 1648-M-97 with Plan Case 1649-M-97 and consolidate

Plan Case No. 1648-CP-97 and Plan Case 1649-CP-97. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Ryan.

Following debate, Alderman Taylor requested a five minute recess. There were no objections. The Council recessed at 8:24 p.m. and reconvened at 8:31 p.m. with all Members of the Council previously in attendance still present.

Alderman Taylor moved a friendly amendment to the motion on the floor, that the Plan Commission be requested to consider Plan Case No. 1649 along with Plan Case No. 1648. The motion was not acceptable to the mover.

Alderman Pollock challenged the validity of the motion on the floor, as the original ordinances had not been moved.

Mayor Satterthwaite declared the motion out of order.

Alderwoman Ryan moved to approve An Amendment To A Part
Of The Zoning Ordinance And Zoning Map Of the City Of Urbana,
Illinois (Poplar-Water Area Of East Main Street/Railroad
Residential Area, Plan Case No. 1648-M-97) and An Amendment To
The Comprehensive Plan Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (PoplarWater Area Of East Main Street/Railroad Residential Area, Plan
Case 1648-CP-97), as amended in Alderwoman Patt's previous
motion. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt.

Alderman Pollock moved to defer. The motion was seconded by Alderman Whelan.

An Amendment To A Part Of The Zoning Ordinance And
Zoning Map Of the City Of Urbana, Illinois (Poplar-Water Area Of

East Main Street/Railroad Residential Area, Plan Case No. 1648-M-97) and An Amendment To The Comprehensive Plan Of The City Of

Urbana, Illinois (Poplar-Water Area Of East Main Street/Railroad Residential Area, Plan Case 1648-CP-97) were deferred until the April 21, 1997 City Council meeting for action and will appear on the April 14, 1997 agenda of the Committee on Administration & Finance for discussion.

Alderman Pollock moved that by motion of the Council, the Plan Commission consider Plan Case 1649, if time permits, at the Plan Commission meeting on April 10, 1997, and send it back to the Committee meeting on April 14. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Ryan and carried by a voice vote.

Alderman Taylor moved to approve An Ordinance Vacating

A Portion Of Orchard Street And A Portion Of Clark Street. The

motion was seconded by Alderman Whelan and carried 6-0 by roll

call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Kearns,

Patt, Pollock, Ryan, Taylor and Whelan - 6; voting nay: none.

Alderman Taylor moved to approve An Ordinance Amending

The Urbana Liquor Code (Closing Hour). The motion was seconded

by Alderwoman Kearns and carried by a roll call vote. Voting aye

were Members of the Council: Kearns, Patt, Pollock, Ryan, Taylor

and Whelan - 6; voting nay: none.

## <u>ADJOURNMENT</u>

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Satterthwaite declared the meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
