# MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Alderwoman Kearns moved to approve the minutes of the February 16, 1998 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt and carried by a voice vote.

Alderwoman Kearns moved to approve <u>Ord. No. 9798-88: An Ordinance Revising The</u> Annual Budget Ordinance (Fire Department/U of I Contract. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Wyman, and Mayor Satterthwaite - 6; voting nay: none; voting present: Huth - 1. Mayor Satterthwaite declared that the present vote would be counted with the majority, making the vote 7-0.

Alderwoman Kearns moved to approve <u>Ord. No. 9798-89: An Ordinance Revising The</u> <u>Annual Budget Ordinance (Corridor Property Subsidy)</u>. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt and carried 7-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Wyman, and Mayor Satterthwaite - 7; voting nay: none.

Alderwoman Kearns moved to adopt Ord. No. 9798-90: An Ordinance Approving Relocation Agreements And A Memorandum Of Understanding Between Illinois Power Company And The City Of Urbana, Illinois, And Authorizing The Execution Of Utility Easements (Stone Creek Subdivision). The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt and carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, and Wyman - 6; voting nay: none.

Alderwoman Kearns moved to adopt **Res. No. 9798-R24: Supplemental Resolution For Improvement By Municipality Under The Illinois Highway Code.** The motion was seconded by Alderman Hayes and carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, and Wyman - 6; voting nay: none.

Alderman Taylor moved to table the vote on the **Release Of Closed Meeting Minutes** until after discussion of item H.2. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt and carried by a voice vote.

# NEW BUSINESS

Community Development Director April Getchius presented staff report on <u>Ord. No. 9798-</u> 91: An Ordinance Approving And Causing Publication Of The Official Zoning Map Of The City Of <u>Urbana, Illinois (Plan Case No. 1689-M-98)</u>, stating that the Illinois Municipal Code requires municipal authorities to publish a new Official Zoning Map to reflect annexations, zoning changes, subdivisions and other map corrections by March 31 of each year. Staff recommends approval.

Alderwoman Patt moved to approve Ord. No. 9798-91: An Ordinance Approving And Causing Publication Of The Official Zoning Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (Plan Case No. 1689-M-98). The motion was seconded by Alderman Hayes and carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, and Wyman - 6; voting nay: none.

Ms. Getchius presented staff report on Ord. No. 9798-92: An Ordinance Approving A Preliminary Plat (Stone Creek Commons Subdivision - Plan Case No. 1687-S-98). The property, commonly referred to as Rose Farm, is located at the southeast corner of Philo and Windsor Roads and totals approximately 60 acres. Lots 401 through 406 are zoned B-3 General Business. Lot 500 is zoned R-4 Medium Density Multiple Family Residential per an annexation agreement approved by the Urbana City Council.

Following debate, Alderman Taylor moved to approve Ord. No. 9798-92: An Ordinance Approving A Preliminary Plat (Stone Creek Commons Subdivision - Plan Case No. 1687-S-98). The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Kearns and carried 5-1 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, and Wyman - 5; voting nay: Huth - 1.

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Alderman Taylor stated that the Rules Committee recommends that the following closed

Alderman Taylor moved to release the approved minutes and not release the minutes still

in need of confidentiality. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Wyman and carried by a

voice vote.
