## SPECIAL MEETING URBANA CITY COUNCIL MONDAY, JUNE 22, 1998

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in special session at 7:30 p.m., Monday, June 22, 1998 in the Urbana City Council Chambers at 400 South Vine Street.

Present at the meeting were Members of the Council:

There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order at 7:31 p.m. by Mayor Satterthwaite.

Mayor Satterthwaite stated that the purpose of this meeting is to consider: 1)Ord. No. 9798-134: An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory To The City Of Urbana (2701 E. Greystone Court); 2) Ord. No. 9798-135: An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory To The City Of Urbana (Beringer Commons Subdivision No. 1/Involuntary Annexation); and 3) Res. No. 9798-R35: A Resolution Regarding An Application By The Housing Authority Of Champaign County For HOPE VI Funds.

Urbana of approximately \$655,000, including \$135,000 in FY19981999 Community Development Block Grant and HOME funds for
development of on-site fixed-rent units.

Mr. Stoffel presented staff report on Res. No. 9798-R35: A Resolution Regarding An Application By The Housing
Authority Of Champaign County For HOPE VI. Following debate,
Alderwoman Patt moved to adopt the resolution, as amended by adding the language suggested by Mr. Stoffel. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hayes and carried by a voice vote.
