Of Right-Of-Ways (Provena Hospitals). The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Kearns and carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor and

Wyman – 6; voting nay: none.

Alderman Hayes stated that the next meeting of the Committee of the Whole will be at 7:30 p.m. this evening, following this special meeting of the Urbana City Council.

Mayor Satterthwaite presented the following people for consideration as appointments to the Historic Preservation Commission: Blair Lachlan, term to expire June 30, 2000; Paul Ecklor, term to

the appointments to the Historic Preservation Commission carried by a voice vote.

Mayor Satterthwaite recommended the approval of William DeJarnette to the position of

Information Services Manager and stated his qualifications.

Alderwoman Wyman moved the appointment of William De Jarnette to the position of

Information Services Manager. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Kearns and carried by a voice vote.
