Alderman Whelan moved to approve **Annual Staff Appointments** as presented by Mayor Satterthwaite. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hayes. Following debate, the motion to approve **Annual Staff Appointments** carried by a voice vote.

Community Development Director April Getchius presented staff report on Ord. No. 1999-06-045: An Ordinance Approving Miscellaneous Amendments To The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (Plan Case 1716-T-99) stating that she, as Urbana Zoning Administrator, is petitioning to amend the text of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance to make various changes and additions.

These changes are generally clarifications or refinements.

Following debate, Alderman Whelan moved to approve Ord. No. 1999-06-045: An Ordinance Approving Miscellaneous Amendments To The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (Plan Case 1716-T-99). The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Kearns.

Alderwoman Patt moved to remove from the motion the section amending *Section VIII-3I*, *Location of Parking Facilities*., and have it included with the other items that are now under consideration by the Plan Commission. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hayes and carried by a voice vote.

The main motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Whelan and Wyman – 6; voting nay: none.

Ms. Getchius presented staff report on Ord. No. 1999-06-046: An Amendment To The

Comprehensive Plan Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (506 E. Anthony, Plan Case No. 1720-CP
99) stating that the Urbana Zoning Administrator is petitioning the City of Urbana for a Comprehensive Plan

Amendment to change the future land use designation of a 5.17 acre site located at 506 E. Anthony,

Urbana, Illinois, from Industrial to Commercial designation.

The Plan Commission found that the comprehensive plan should not be amended for a single lot. Also, the proximity of the property to North Cunningham Avenue, Interstate 74, and existing commercial uses make the request to rezone from IN, Industrial to B-3, General Business appropriate.

Staff recommends approval of the amendment.

Following debate, the main motion to approve Ord. No. 1999-06-046: An Amendment To

The Comprehensive Plan Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (506 E. Anthony, Plan Case No. 1720
CP-99) carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor,

Whelan and Wyman – 6; voting nay: none.

Ms. Getchius presented staff report on Ord. No. 1999-06-047: An Amendment To The Zoning Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (506 E. Anthony, Plan Case No. 1720-M-99) stating that this is a rezoning request from James Hurlbert to rezone the 5.17 acre site at 506 E. Anthony from Industrial to B-3 General Business.

The Plan Commission and staff both recommend support of this request.

Alderman Whelan moved to approve <u>Ord. No. 1999-06-047</u>: An Amendment To The <u>Zoning Map Of The City Of Urbana, Illinois (506 E. Anthony, Plan Case No. 1720-M-99)</u>. The motion was seconded by Alderman Taylor and carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Whelan and Wyman – 6; voting nay: none.

Mayor Satterthwaite presented staff report on Ord. No. 1999-06-050: An Ordinance

Amending Ordinance No. 1999-05-024 Entitled "An Ordinance Vacating A Portion Of High Street"

stating that when Council passed Ord. No. 1999-05-024 on May 3, 1999, a standard paragraph reserving easements for public utilities in place was inadvertently left out. Ord. No. 1999-06-050 includes that omitted paragraph.

Alderwoman Kearns moved to approve Ord. No. 1999-06-050: An Ordinance Amending

Ordinance No. 1999-05-024 Entitled "An Ordinance Vacating A Portion Of High Street". The motion

was seconded by Alderwoman Wyman and carried 7-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the

Council: Hayes, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Whelan, Wyman and Mayor Satterthwaite – 7; voting nay: none.
