Mayor Satterthwaite called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Alderman Taylor noted that in last week's edition of "Letters to the Editor" in The News-Gazette, there was a letter commending Barb Stiehl (Secretary/Public Works Department) for her promptness regarding a parking meter. Mayor Satterthwaite acknowledge receipt of a copy of the newspaper article and indicated this action as "typical" of Barb's nature and what she does for the City. Ms Stiehl's efforts in providing good service on behalf of the City of Urbana are greatly appreciated.

Alderpersons Patt and Whelan addressed comments and concerns they had received from residents concerning the "Art in the Park" display. Suggestions made included having a mechanism for people to leave comments, and extend the time for viewing the display in order to allow people who are on vacation to see it upon their return. Alderwoman Patt also noted a complaint she received indicating that the sculpture would be too big and too close to the street.

Mayor Satterthwaite will direct staff to formalize the display area with a suggestion/comment box for the public to use.

Anyone wishing to view the "Art in the Park" display may do so at the City Building. The display is located outside the Council Chambers door.

Alderman Taylor commended Phyllis Clark (City Clerk) and Jack Waaler (City Attorney) for their efforts in complying with the Statutes pertaining to the examination of closed session minutes and distributing them to the Council for review in the required six-month timeframe.
