**RE: APPROVAL OF HOUSE MOVING PERMIT**

### ACTION REQUESTED

Approval of a moving permit for 2012 North Lincoln Avenue. (See attached photo.)

### BACKGROUND

The Public Works Department has received a request for a house-moving permit to move a structure at 2012 North Lincoln Avenue (the future site of Andrae's Harley Davidson) to a location outside the city limits. City ordinance requires Council approval, by motion, for all moves of this nature.

### RECOMMENDATION

There are minimal conflicts with any infrastructure items. Since the estimated weight of the structure is less than the weight of vehicles that typically cross the bridge over the Saline Branch, north of I-74, the City waives the requirement of a structural engineer's report for the bridge. The requirement for the services of a certified arborist is waived based on the determination by the City Arborist that there are no tree conflicts within the area where the house move will occur. The property is to be relocated outside the city limits.

Recommend authorization for the Director of Public Works to issue a moving permit upon satisfactory submission of all required items.
