RE: Ordinances from Traffic Commission

Attached are two ordinances for your approval from action taken by the Traffic Commission. See attached map for locations.

The first ordinance (Schedule H) is for the placement of a stop sign at Colorado Avenue and Stone Creek Boulevard. This action is needed due to the recent construction of Colorado Avenue from Philo Road to Stone Creek Boulevard as part of the Prairie Winds Subdivision. Currently no traffic control exists for this intersection. It was necessary to install a stop sign on eastbound Colorado Avenue to stop for Stone Creek Boulevard. These stop signs are needed and warranted under Section 2B-05 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. More specifically this warrant states that a stop sign may be warranted if one or more of the following conditions exist:

1. Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous.
2. Street entering a through highway or street.
3. Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
4. Other intersections where a combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident record indicates a need for control by the STOP sign.

The conditions are met for numbers 1 and 2 above are met for all intersections in the ordinance.

The Traffic Commission has considered this location at its September, 2005 meeting and recommends that the stop sign be installed.

The second ordinance (Schedule J) is for the installation of no parking on the west side of Abercorn Street, Montgomery Street, and Ogelthorpe Street from Michigan Avenue to Rainbowview Drive. This parking restriction was needed due to the narrow streets built as part of the Savannah Green Subdivision. These streets were recently completed and this ordinance will extend the no parking restrictions previously instituted on these same streets south of Michigan Avenue to Florida Avenue.

The Traffic Commission has considered this restriction at its September, 2005 meeting and recommends that the no parking zones be installed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Abercorn Street; Montgomery Street; Ogelthorpe Avenue)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>
Abercorn Street	From the centerline of Michigan Avenue to the centerline of Rainbow View.	West Side
Montgomery Street	From the centerline of Michigan Avenue to the centerline of Rainbow View.	West Side
Ogelthorpe Avenue	From the centerline of Michigan Avenue to the centerline of Rainbow View.	West Side

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the

effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

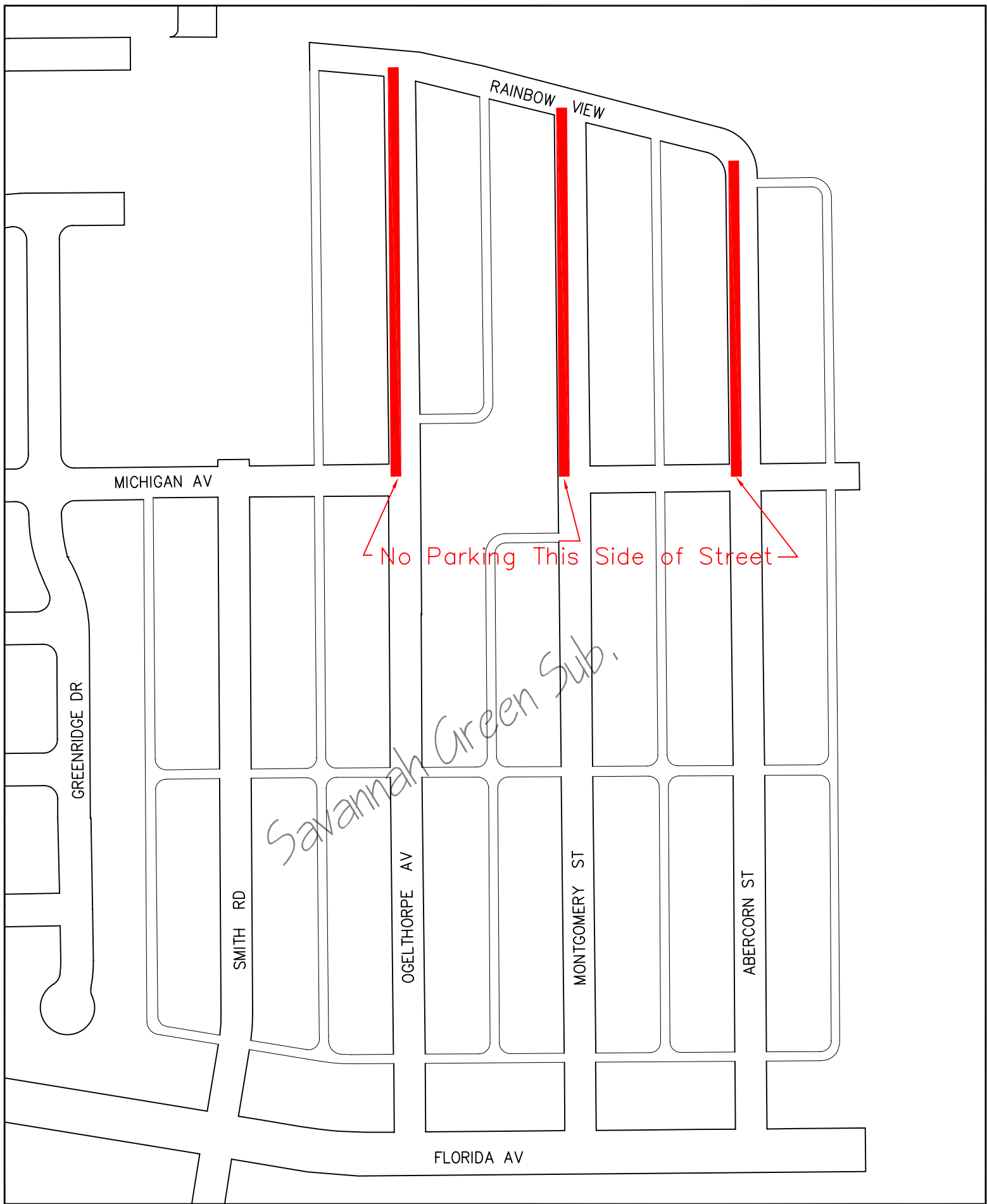
