Introduction

Attached is the proposed project location map for subject project Resolution to be considered at the Monday, October 10th, 2005 Committee of the Whole meeting. All proposed work is based upon concrete street repair needs identified in the Capital Improvement Plan.

The street locations included in this project are:

Race Street – Florida Avenue to Windsor Road
Windsor Road – West of Race Street to East of Clark Lindsay Village
Water Street – Broadway Avenue to Vine Street
Walnut Street – Main Street to Water Street
Florida Avenue – Vine Street to Philo Road

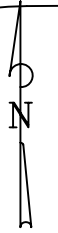
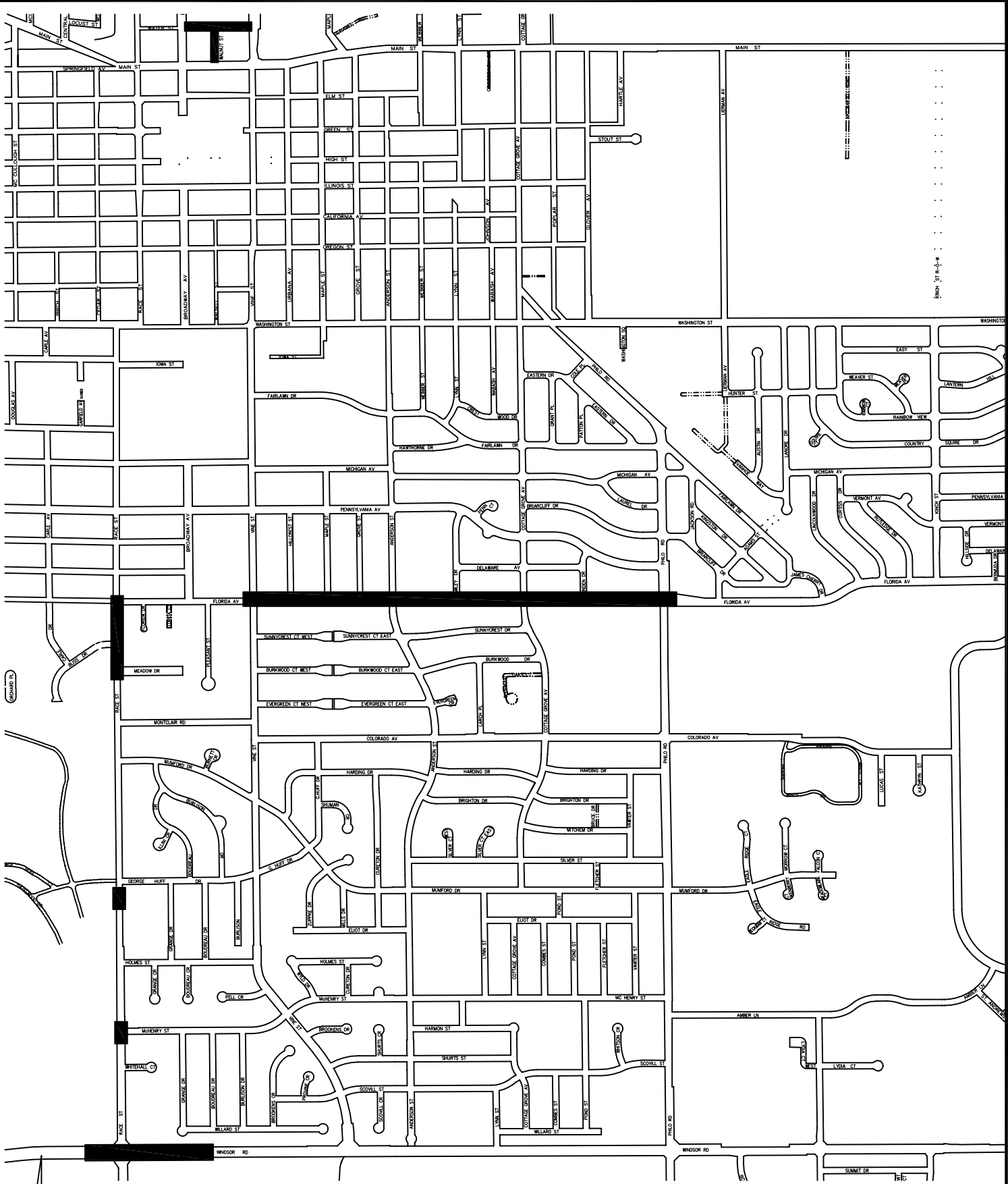
The proposed work involves: removal of deteriorated concrete pavement and replacement with new concrete pavement; removal and replacement of curb and gutter; removal and replacement of sidewalk ramps; and miscellaneous storm sewer repairs.

Fiscal Impact

The total cost of the project is not to exceed \$650,000. The attached resolution requests use of Motor Fuel Tax monies to be appropriated.

Council Action

The City Council is asked to approve a Resolution for Improvement by Municipality Under the Illinois Highway Code in the amount of \$650,000.

Resolution for Maintenance of Streets and Highways by Municipality Under the Illinois Highway Code

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$650,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the purpose of maintaining streets and highways under the applicable provisions of the Illinois Highway Code from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that only those streets, highways, and operations as listed and described on the approved Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs, including supplemental or revised estimates approved in connection with this resolution, are eligible for maintenance with Motor Fuel Tax funds during the period as specified above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk shall, as soon a practicable after the close of the period as given above, submit to the Department of Transportation, on forms furnished by said Department, a certified statement showing expenditures from and balances remaining in the account(s) for this period; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk shall immediately transmit two certified copies of this resolution to the district office of the Department of Transportation, at Paris, Illinois.
