**RE:** Ordinances from Traffic Commission

Attached are three ordinances for City Council consideration from action taken by the Urbana Traffic Commission at its November 7<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The first ordinance (Schedule A) is for the establishment of altered state speed limits on Philo Road from Mumford Drive to Windsor Road. Currently, the speed limit is posted at 40 MPH on Philo Road. The speed limit on Philo Road is to be posted at 35 MPH based upon the results of an engineering study. The recommended speed of 35 MPH will improve safety and visibility from entering and exiting vehicles and other planned access points along Philo Road.

The second ordinance (Schedule H) is for the placement of stop signs for eastbound and westbound traffic on Brighton Drive and Harding Drive at Cottage Grove Avenue and for westbound traffic on Mitchem Drive at Cottage Grove Avenue. The stop signs are required due to the increase of visibility obstructions along the intersections in this area. These stop signs are needed and warranted under Section 2B-5 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. More specifically, these warrants state that a stop sign may be warranted if one or more of the following conditions exist:

- 1. Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous.
- 2. Street entering a through highway or street.
- 3. Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
- 4. Other intersections where a combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident record indicates a need for control by the STOP sign.

The conditions are met for numbers 1 and 2 above on Brighton Drive, Mitchem Drive and Harding Drive at Cottage Grove Avenue.

The third ordinance (Schedule J) is for the restriction of parking on the south side of Rainbow View between Smith Road and the easternmost end of Rainbow View. The location of the restriction is on the north side of Rainbow View, east of Smith Road. This parking restriction is being requested by residents in the Savannah Green Subdivision who noticed that vehicles parked along both sides of the street were narrowing the flow of traffic to one lane along Rainbow View. With this parking restriction, traffic will have adequate room to maneuver on Rainbow View and parking will be maximized by using the north side of the street.

### ORDINANCE NO. 2006-11-139

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE A OF SECTION 23-62 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE INCREASING STATE SPEED LIMITS IN CERTAIN ZONES

#### (Philo Road)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule A of Section 23-62, entitled "Increasing State Speed Limits in Certain Zones" of Article V of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following speed regulations for a certain portion of Philo Road:

From the north right-of-way of Mumford Drive to the south right-of-way of Windsor Road the speed limit shall be thirty-five miles per hour (35 MPH).

Section 2. That the Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to post the appropriate signs indicating the speed regulations set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.
