RE: Ordinance from Traffic Commission Meeting

Attached is an ordinance for approval from action taken by the Urbana Traffic Commission.

The ordinance (Schedule J) prohibits parking at all times on the both sides of Colorado Avenue from Philo Road to Prairie Winds Drive and on the south side of Colorado Avenue from Prairie Winds Drive to Stone Creek Boulevard. Colorado Avenue is a street 45 feet in width at the intersection of Colorado Avenue and Philo Road that provides for three lanes of traffic and reduces to 30 feet in width (one lane in each direction) east of Prairie Winds Drive. Since Colorado Avenue is classified as a collector street for the properties between Prairie Winds Drive and Philo Road, no parking would be allowed on either side of the street. To the east of Prairie Winds Drive, Colorado Avenue is reduced in width allowing for parking on one side of the street. Since there are no residential properties facing the street on the south side, it is recommended that no parking be allowed on the south side of Colorado Avenue.

The Traffic Commission has considered this location at its April 2009 meeting and recommends that the ordinance be passed by the City Council.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Colorado Avenue)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>
Colorado Avenue	From the centerline of Philo Road Avenue to the centerline of Prairie Winds Drive	Both Sides
Colorado Avenue	From the centerline of Prairie Winds Drive to the centerline of Stone Creek Boulevard	South Side

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
