The City of Urbana, Ill., Public Works Department consists of 80 employees and six divisions, including administration, arbor, engineering, environmental sustainability, fleet, and operations, which track monthly data on recycling and reuse efforts. Urbana Public Works has been tracking data since 2012. Materials tracked include items such as batteries, oil, antifreeze, tires, solvents, landscape materials, concrete, asphalt, lamps, scrap metal, and more. In 2017, the Urbana Public Works Department recycled more than 9,600 tons of materials including C&D, and achieved a 90% diversion rate.
