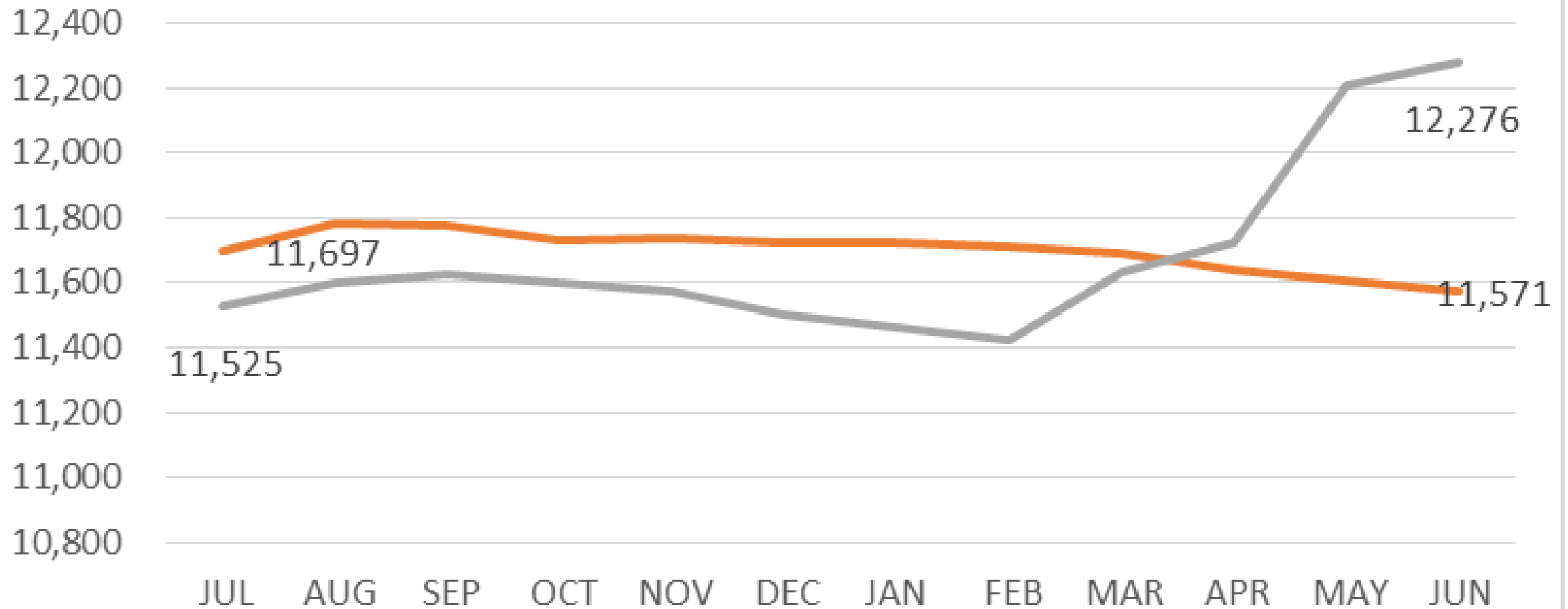

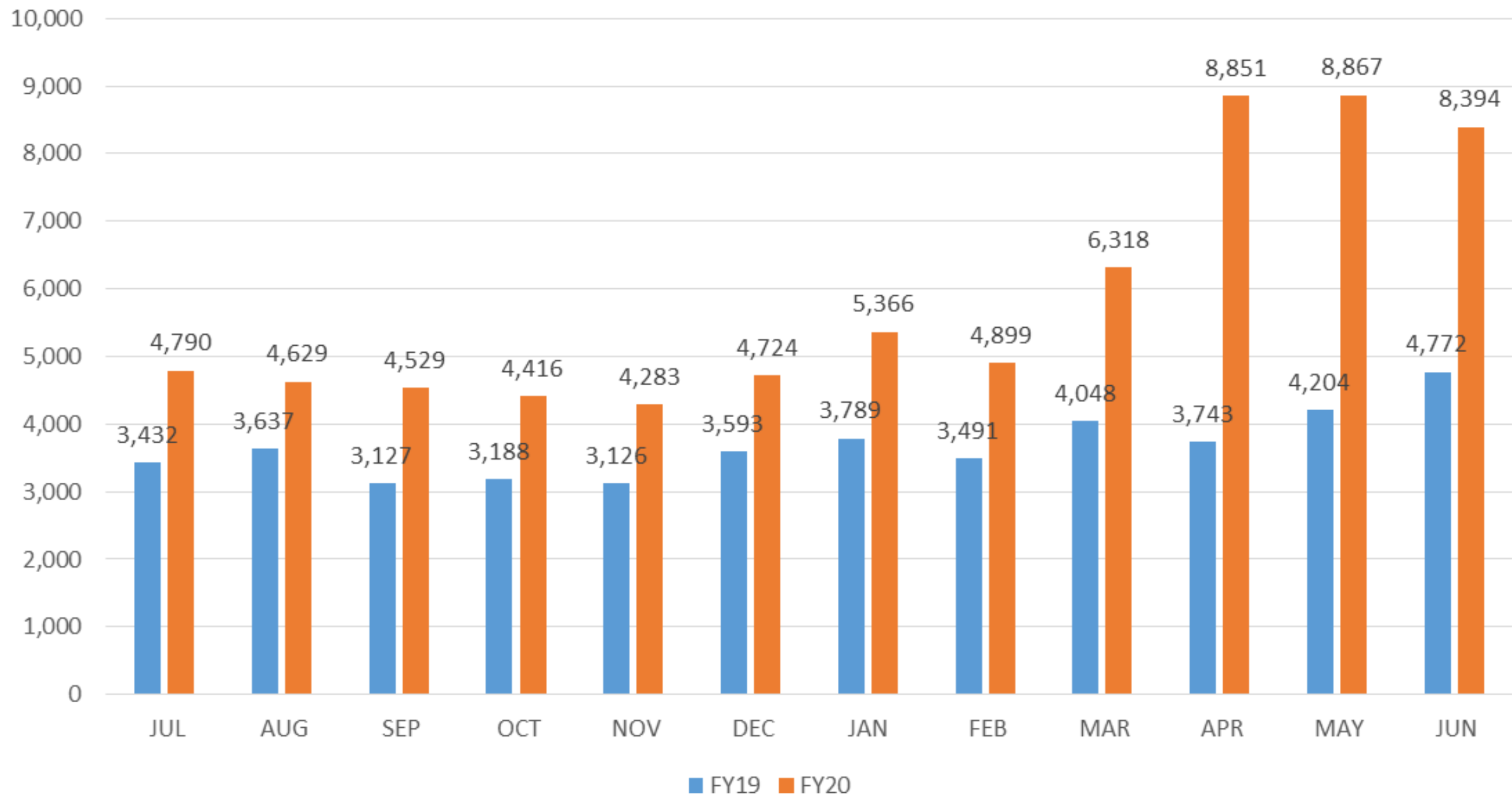
Cardholders
