RE: City Commitment of Local Funds for the Community Development

Assistance Program [CDAP] Grant for the Scottswood Subdivision

INTRODUCTION

The Champaign County Regional Planning Commission [RPC], Urbana Township, and the City of Urbana have cooperated to date in studying the causes and finding solutions to flooding in the Scottswood Subdivision. Previously, a CDAP Grant was obtained for a drainage study, which was completed last year. RPC is now applying for another CDAP Grant for Engineering Services and the application deadline is October 2, 2001.

A significant component of the engineering design phase is the necessity to clean and televise the existing storm sewers. This is a large undertaking which can be accomplished with the use of Public Works crews. It is known that successful CDAP Grant applications are leveraged by large in-kind or cash contributions. In this case, the CDAP Grant could be up to \$100,000 of which the total project costs would be \$178,000 (see attached "Project Activity Description").

Staff believes it is in the City's long-term interest for the Scottswood Subdivision to some day become annexed. Improving the drainage and storm sewer system is one large step toward making annexation desirable.

A requirement of the grant application process is for local agencies' sponsors to approve a resolution committing in-kind services or local funds. Attached please find a draft resolution that is to be considered by the City Council.

If this grant is received, sewer cleaning work would occur next calendar year.

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FISCAL IMPACT

Public Works Department crews would be asked to spend six to eight weeks cleaning and televising the most important storm sewers in the subdivision. It is believed that these sewers have not received any kind of maintenance or cleaning in the past. The total cost for cleaning and televising storm sewers is estimated at \$100,000. The out-of-pocket expenses to the City for wages and material would be approximately \$50,000 of which \$26,000 would be reimbursed by the CDAP Grant. The additional \$50,000 expense (soft-cost) is the in-house rental rate charge for equipment.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached "Resolution Committing Local Funds for the Development Assistance Program Grant for Scottswood Subdivision" be approved.
