There being a quorum, in the absence of Mr. Whelan, Mr. Otto assumed the Chair and called the meeting to order at 7:34 p.m.

## Additions to the Agenda and Staff Report

Mayor Satterthwaite announced the Local Planning Matters Conference, which is being held at the Illini Union on February 26-27, 2003 and stated that anyone wanting to attend could contact his office.

Mayor Satterthwaite requested that, since the only **Public Input** is in response to Resolution No. 2003-01-002R: Resolution Opposing War Against Iraq, that Public Input be moved to item number 8 on the agenda. There were no objections.

#### Minutes of Previous Meeting

Ms. Wyman moved to approve the January 13, 2003 minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Huth and carried by a voice vote.

# Ordinance No. 2003-01-001: An Ordinance Amending Schedule K of Section 23-184 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Prohibiting Parking During Certain Hours on Certain Streets (Nevada Street)

Public Works Director Bill Gray presented staff report stating this ordinance was forwarded from the January 13, 2003 Committee of the Whole Meeting.

Ms. Patt moved to forward <u>Ordinance No. 2003-01-001: An Ordinance Amending Schedule K of</u> <u>Section 23-184 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Prohibiting Parking During Certain Hours on Certain</u> <u>Streets (Nevada Street)</u> to Council with a recommendation for approval. The motion was seconded by Ms. Wyman and carried by a voice vote.

# Ordinance No. 2003-01-008: An Ordinance Approving and Authorizing the Execution of an Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement With the County of Champaign (Funding for Combined Design Report for Windsor Road)

Mr. Gray presented staff report stating that the Champaign-Urbana Urbanized Area Transportation Study (CUUATS) has identified the Windsor Road project as eligible for federal funding. The first step in satisfying the requirements for federal funding is to perform a Phase I Engineering Study or Combined Design Report.

This report is estimated to cost no more than \$210,000. Federal Surface Transportation Program-Urban Funds will pay for 50% or up to \$105,000 for this study. The balance of the \$105,000 would be split equally between the City and the County, for a maximum of \$52,500 for each agency.

Mr. Hayes moved to forward <u>Ordinance No. 2003-01-008: An Ordinance Approving and</u> <u>Authorizing the Execution of an Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement With the County of</u> <u>Champaign (Funding for Combined Design Report for Windsor Road)</u> to Council for approval. The motion was seconded by Ms. Wyman and carried by a voice vote.

# Ordinance No. 2003-01-009: An Ordinance Amending Section 23-211 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Relating to Parking Violation Procedures

City Attorney Jack Waaler presented staff report stating that this is a language change. Since tickets are now issued electronically and show the officer's identification number but no signature, the ordinance needs to be amended to remove reference to the signature of the person issuing the notice.

Ms. Wyman moved to forward <u>Ordinance No. 2003-01-009: An Ordinance Amending Section 23-</u> 211 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Relating to Parking Violation Procedures to Council with a recommendation for approval. The motion was seconded by Ms. Chynoweth and carried by a voice vote.

# Landfill Update

Mr. Gray presented staff report. On Friday, January 24, City staff and our hydro geologic consultant, representatives from the University of Illinois, local IEPA officials and an attorney from the Illinois Attorney General's office met. The meeting was called by the Attorney General's office to share information gathered to date concerning discharges along the Saline. A site investigation report was prepared by City staff, and provided a basis for review. This report was presented prior to this meeting. (A copy of that report is attached.)
