ORDINANCE NO. 2003-01-001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE K OF SECTION 23-184 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Nevada Street)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule K of Section 23-184, entitled "Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle on the designated days or times:

| <u>Street</u> | <u>Side of Street</u> | <u>Between</u> | <u>Days</u> |
|---------------|-----------------------|----------------------------------|-----------------------|
| Nevada Street | South | Vine Street and Walnut Street | Monday through Friday |

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
