Community Development Director Libby Tyler presented a report on **B-1 (Neighborhood** 

**Business)** Zoning District. The B-1 district is intended to offer convenient commercial services for the benefit of the neighborhood. On September 23, 2002 the City Council asked staff to further study the B-1 district and present ideas on how it could be improved. This report serves three purposes. It offers a more detailed analysis of existing B-1 zone properties; examines all the existing Urbana Zoning Ordinance regulations pertaining to B-1; and offers conceptual ideas for amendments to the district that could be considered in order to achieve the goal of compatibility with adjacent residential uses.

Debate ensued. The <u>B-1 (Neighborhood Business) Zoning District</u> will return for further discussion at a later Council/Committee meeting.
