**MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

Alderman Patt moved approval of the minutes of the January 21, 2003 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Wyman and carried by a voice vote.

Alderman Otto moved to approve **Ordinance No. 2003-01-008: An Ordinance Approving and Authorizing the Execution of an Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement With the County of Champaign (Funding for Combined Design Report for Windsor Road)**. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Wyman and carried 7-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Chynoweth, Hayes, Huth, Otto, Patt, Whelan, and Wyman – 7; voting nay: none.

Alderman Otto moved to approve **Ordinance No. 2003-01-009: An Ordinance Amending Section 23-211 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Relating to Parking Violation Procedures**. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Wyman and carried 7-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Chynoweth, Hayes, Huth, Otto, Patt, Whelan, and Wyman – 7; voting nay: none.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Community Development Director Libby Tyler presented a report on **B-1 (Neighborhood Business) Zoning District**. The B-1 district is intended to offer convenient commercial services for the benefit of the neighborhood. On September 23, 2002 the City Council asked staff to further study the B-1 district and present ideas on how it could be improved. This report serves three purposes. It offers a more detailed analysis of existing B-1 zone properties; examines all the existing Urbana Zoning Ordinance regulations pertaining to B-1; and offers conceptual ideas for amendments to the district that could be considered in order to achieve the goal of compatibility with adjacent residential uses.

Debate ensued. The **B-1 (Neighborhood Business) Zoning District** will return for further discussion at a later Council/Committee meeting.
