RE: Motor Fuel Tax Construction Resolution for Washington and Vine Improvement

Introduction

Attached is the proposed Resolution and supporting documentation for the Washington Street and Vine Street Motor Fuel Tax Construction Resolution to be considered at next Monday's (April 14th, 2003) Committee meeting. All proposed work is based upon needs identified in the Capital Improvement Plan.

The project consists of the complete removal of existing pavement and replacement with a new PC concrete pavement, new driveway approaches and various sidewalk patches. The project limits are Washington Street from Walnut Street to Urbana Avenue and Vine Street from Illinois Street to south of Washington Street. The intersection of Washington Street and Vine Street will be widened to accommodate larger turning radii vehicles. Traffic signals are not being included at this time.

Fiscal Impact

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$925,000. The Resolution requests \$925,000 of MFT monies to be appropriated.

Council Action

The City Council is asked to approve the attached Construction Resolution in the amount of \$925,000.

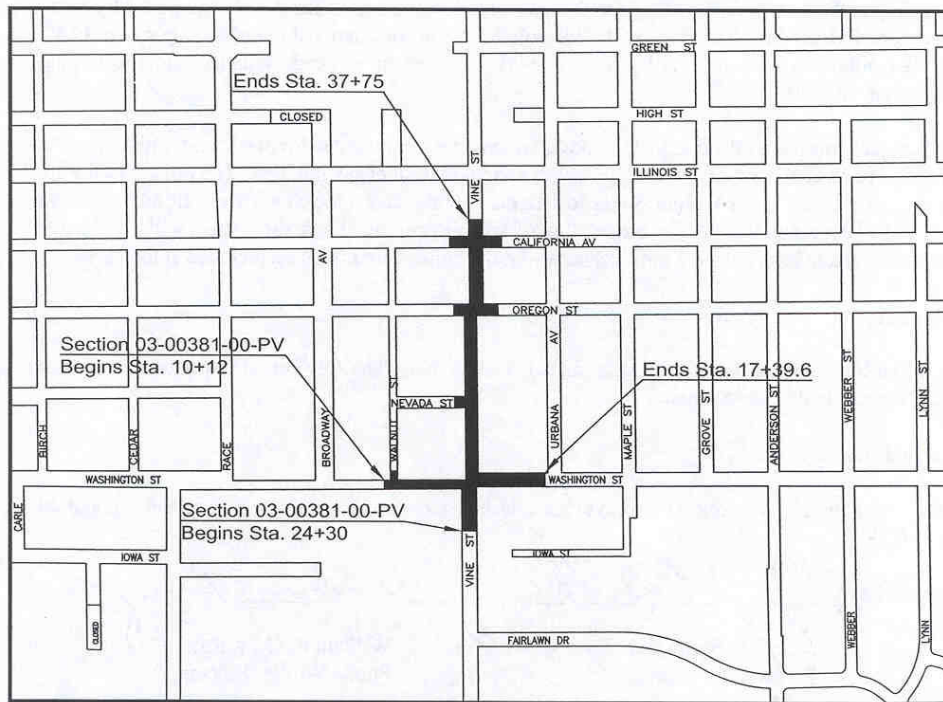
