# URBANA CITY COUNCIL MEETING May 19, 2003

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in regular session at 7:30 p.m., Monday,

May 19, 2003 in the Urbana City Council Chambers at 400 South Vine Street.

There being a quorum, Mayor Satterthwaite called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

Chief Administrative Office Bruce Walden stated that Council had a handout on their desks that is a complete history of water company negotiations and history of the franchises with the water that was produced by the Champaign Legal Department. Sometime in June, there will be discussion at a Committee meeting on how to approach this situation.

Police Chief Eddie Adair discussed the disappearance of Tyeeste Jones on Sunday, May 18, 2003. Since the disappearance the Urbana Police Department has conducted an ongoing, continuous investigation in to this disappearance. As of this time, the child has not been located. The abduction occurred at 905 East Colorado. An Amber alert was implemented at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 18, 2003. The Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Illinois State Police and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children are working in partnership with the Urbana Police Department on this disappearance.
