#### G. REPORTS OF OFFICERS

The following reports were made prior to the item presented on the agenda:

Bruce Walden (Chief Administrative Officer) reported on the heavy storm that occurred last Tuesday, leaving downed trees and limbs. Because the City of Urbana was not hit relatively hard, Public Works staff responded quickly and was able to have everything cleared by Wednesday afternoon. Staff also assisted the City of Champaign with clean up.

Mayor Satterthwaite informed the Council that he had received a copy of a "Second Cooperative Agreement" that was passed by the Library Board and the Library Foundation Board regarding the Urbana Free Library Expansion Project. Since the Tepper building will no longer be available to the City as income property, the agreement addresses a \$75,000 contribution from the Foundation to the City for the purchase of the Marro building and the City's ability to use the Marro building for income property in the near term. This issue will be presented at next week's Committee Of The Whole meeting.
