SUBJECT: Annexation of a 20.76+-acre parcel located at 1901 South High Cross Road.

Currently owned by Wendl, Inc., an Illinois Corporation. Commonly known as

Wendl's Restaurant and Sports Complex.

Introduction & Background

Staff is requesting the City Council to consider the attached ordinance on Monday, March 21, 2005 to annex a tract of land totaling approximately 20.76 acres, located at 1901 South High Cross Road. The tract is owned by Wendl, Inc. The site is covered by an annexation agreement to be reviewed by City Council at their Committee meeting on March 14, 2005 and to be considered for approval at the regular Council meeting of March 21, 2005. As the officer of Wendl, Inc., Mr. Jeff Wendling has signed a petition requesting the property now be annexed into the City of Urbana. The proposed effective date of the annexation is March 22, 2005.

Issues and Discussion

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-03-037

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory To The City Of Urbana (Approximately 20.76 Acres Located at 1901 S. High Cross Road - T.K. Wendl)

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois and includes certain territory within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the Philo Fire Protection District, the Board of Urbana Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on Monday, March 7, 2005, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 p.m., Monday, March 21, 2005, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, on the 9th day of March, 2005; and

WHEREAS, a written petition signed by the Owner of Record has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. _____ on March 21, 2005 approving and authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed by this Ordinance is presently located within Champaign County's B-4, General Business zoning district and upon annexation the tract will be classified B-3, General Business in accordance with the above-referenced annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said petition complies with all requirements of the law therefore; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz.:

All of Lot 1 of Emergo First Subdivision, Champaign County, Illinois, per plat recorded in Plat Book BB, at page 281, in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, Champaign County, Illinois, all situated in Urbana Township, Champaign County, Illinois and encompassing 20.76 Acres, more or less.

Commonly know for reference as 1901 S. High Cross Road, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois. The above-described parcel, prior to annexation, has the parcel index number of 30-21-22-280-001, and following annexation the said parcel should bear the parcel index number of 93-21-280-001.


Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory herein above described in the Recorder's Office of Champaign County, Illinois in the Office of the County Clerk and County Election Authority of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section $\underline{4}$. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to classify the real property herein annexed as B-3, General Business upon annexation and in accordance with an annexation agreement approved and authorized on March 21, 2005 by Council Ordinance No. _______.

 $\underline{\text{Section 5}}$. The territory annexed herein is assigned to City of Urbana Ward 6.

 $\underline{\text{Section 6}}$. To avoid uncertainty regarding public safety responsibilities concerning the property herein annexed, this Ordinance shall take effect at noon on the 22nd day of March 2005 following its passage by the Urbana City Council.



1. Petitioner is the sole owner of record of the following legally described land (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Tract), except any public right-of-way property to wit:
