RESOLUTION NO. 2005-12-025R

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT LINCOLN (F.A.U. ROUTE 7177) AVENUE AND PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE

(Lincoln Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue)

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has entered into an Agreement with the State of Illinois for the installation of the traffic signal at the intersection of Lincoln Avenue (FAU 7177) with Pennsylvania Avenue; known as City Section 04-00396-00-TL; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the aforementioned Agreement, it is necessary for the City to appropriate sufficient funds to pay its share of the cost of said improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, from any money now or hereinafter allotted to the City to pay for its share of the cost of this improvement as described in the Agreement.

Section 2. That upon receipt of the contractor's first and subsequent progressive bills for this improvement, the City will pay to the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois an amount equal to the city's share of the construction cost divided by the estimated total cost, multiplied by the actual payment (appropriately adjusted for any non-participation costs of FAU Projects) made to the contractor until the entire obligation incurred under this agreement has been paid.

Section 3. That the City agrees to pass a supplemental resolution to
provide the necessary funds for its share of the cost of this improvement if
the amount appropriated herein proves to be insufficient to cover said cost.
