RE: Ordinances from Traffic Commission

Attached are two ordinances for your approval from action taken by the Traffic Commission at its February 7, 2006 meeting.

The ordinances are for the addition of a no parking zone and four metered parking spaces on the south side of Griggs Street between Race Street and Wood Street, near the Urbana School District Office. This was requested as a result of the loss of parking spaces after the construction of the Stratford apartment building. To provide sufficient visibility for the north-bound stop sign on Wood Street and to restrict parking on the Boneyard Creek bridge, which is part of Griggs Street, parking restrictions have been requested. Maps are attached indicating the location of these ordinance changes.

The Traffic Commission has considered and recommends the attached ordinances.

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-02-023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Griggs Street)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

Street	Between	<u>Side of Street</u>
Griggs Street	From the centerline of Wood Street to 195 feet east of the centerline of Wood Street.	South Side

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance. Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
