The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in special session at 7:00 p.m., Monday, July 24, 2006 in the Urbana City Council Chambers at 400 South Vine Street.

There being a quorum, Mayor Prussing called the meeting called to order at 7:10 p.m.
