RE: Ordinances from Traffic Commission

The first ordinance (Schedule J) is a request to install loading zones on Main Street and Lincoln Avenue. The St. Patrick's Church Food Pantry has requested the loading zone to accommodate those who receive food from the food pantry. The loading zone on the north side of Main Street provides the most accessible route from the parish hall to vehicles receiving food from the food pantry. This 15-minute loading zone will be in effect from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday while the food pantry is open. In addition, loading zones are being requested on the west side of Lincoln Avenue near the commercial area south of Nevada Street and on the east side of Lincoln Avenue near the dormitory residences. Both of these 30-minute loading zones will provide an area for commercial vehicles to load and unload outside the flow of traffic.

The second ordinance (Schedule J) is a request to restrict parking on the north side of Michigan Avenue between Abercorn Street and Montgomery Street. This restriction will comply with the design of the Savannah Green subdivision to allow parking on one side of the street.

The Traffic Commission has considered these locations at its September 2006 meeting and recommends that the ordinance be passed by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-09-119

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Michigan Avenue)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

Street	Between	Side of Street
Michigan Avenue	From the centerline of Abercorn Street to the centerline of Montgomery Street.	North Side

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance

shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


