RE: Amended Agreement #1 for Goodwin Avenue Bike Path Improvement

Introduction

Attached is a proposed resolution Approving an Amendment to an Agreement between the Illinois Department of Transportation and the City of Urbana along with supporting documentation for the Goodwin Avenue Bike Path Project to be considered at Monday's (November 27th, 2006) Committee of the Whole meeting.

This amendment is required to finalize the project funding participation shares between the City of Urbana and the Illinois Department of Transportation. The original agreement had designated federal Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program funds in the amount of \$278,000 which was divided among Preliminary Engineering (\$20,000), Land Acquisition (\$50,000), Utility Relocation (\$22,000), Construction (\$176,000) and Construction Engineering (\$10,000). These figures were based on early cost estimates. As the project moved forward through the design and construction stages, the City consulting engineer was able to design and build the path with no money spent for Land Acquisition or Utility Relocation. However, the design and layout of the bike path became complicated due to satisfying certain IDOT criteria which required additional engineering expenses to redesign the path. City staff requested a transfer of those funds (\$72,000) to Preliminary and Construction Engineering to cover additional costs due to the redesign work. That transfer was approved by IDOT.

Fiscal Impact

Since the transfer was granted the City will now be reimbursed \$62,723.90 of the \$72,000 allowed for City funds already expended towards Preliminary and Construction Engineering. Without this amendment the City will receive none of the \$72,000.
