RE: Ordinance from Traffic Commission

Attached is an ordinance for Council approval from action taken by the Traffic Commission.

The attached ordinance (Schedule H) is for the placement of stop sign on Orchard Street at Oregon Street. This stop sign is required due to the visibility at the intersection; therefore, this stop sign is needed and warranted under Section 2B-5 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. More specifically, these warrants state that a stop sign may be warranted if one or more of the following conditions exist:

- 1. Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-ofway rule is unduly hazardous.
- 2. Street entering a through highway or street.
- 3. Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
- 4. Other intersections where a combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident record indicates a need for control by the STOP sign.

The conditions are met for numbers 1 and 2 above for Orchard Street at Oregon Street.

The Traffic Commission considered this location at its February 2007 meeting and recommends that the stop sign be installed.

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-02-028

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE H OF SECTION 23-93 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE REQUIRING STOP SIGNS AT A CERTAIN INTERSECTION

(Orchard Street at Oregon Street)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule H of Section 23-93, entitled "Stop Signs Pursuant to Section 23-93", of Article VIII of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following intersections where drivers of vehicles shall be required to stop before entering the intersections:

Street		Direction	<u>Street</u>	
Orchard	Street	Southbound	Oregon	Street

<u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays"

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being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
