- **RE:** Ordinance from Traffic Commission

Attached is an ordinance for your approval from action taken by the Urbana Traffic Commission. The ordinance (Schedule J) prohibits parking at all times on Prairie Winds Drive.

The location for the proposed ordinance is on the west side of Prairie Winds Drive, south of Colorado Avenue. The parking restriction is being requested by the developer of the subdivision, who noticed that vehicles parked along the street were constricting the flow and visibility of traffic at the Prairie Winds Supportive Living Facility on Prairie Winds Drive.

The field investigation found that vehicles were parking on both sides of the street narrowed traffic flow to one-way traffic. With the location of the entrance to the assisted living facility along the street, it would be difficult for emergency vehicles to access the entrance.

The Traffic Commission has considered this location at its December 2007 meeting and recommends that the ordinance be passed by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01-003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Prairie Winds Drive)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

Street	Between	<u>Side of Street</u>
Prairie Winds Drive	From the centerline of Colorado Avenue to 525 feet south of the centerline of Colorado Avenue.	West Side

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance. Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


