7. Discussion: Implementing a Car Share Program in Champaign-Urbana

Patrick Pioletti (Public Facilities Manager) gave a staff report. Staff would like the City to participate in a Car Share Program which recognizes MTD as the lead agency, but all participants would split the costs equally. He explained this was a membership based program. Members would pay hourly for vehicle use (possibly \$7-8 per hour with mileage after a certain amount);

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rental fees would include insurance, maintenance and fuel costs; primary members would be residents with no current private transportation in the area; no restrictions would apply to distance allowed. After discussion, Staff advised they would present an agreement with a budget amendment at the next Council meeting in September.

There being no further business to come before the City Council, Mayor Prussing declared the meeting adjourned at 8:58 p.m.
