RE: 2008 I-Help Litter Clean-Up Event

This purpose of this report is to inform the Mayor and members of the City Council of the third annual I-HELP Litter Clean-Up activities that occurred on Saturday, October 4, 2008. Three hundred and fifty volunteers from the University of Illinois clad in orange tee-shirts were deployed from the Quad on campus to clean-up trash and litter throughout Champaign and Urbana. One hundred and thirty student volunteers picked up trash and marked storm sewer inlets with medallions that say "Dump No Waste – Drains to Creek" throughout Urbana.

Sponsors for the 2008 I-HELP Litter Clean-Up included the City of Urbana, City of Champaign, the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign Rotary clubs, and the Village of Savoy. Urbana contributed tee-shirts, storm sewer inlet medallion kits, and trash pickup kits for the event.
