A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE EMPLOYEE FREE CHOICE ACT

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana ("City") is a home rule municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City has the authority to adopt resolutions that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the working people of the United States have the right to form unions and bargain collectively for a better life; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Urbana are concerned about violations of this the rights of working people; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Free Choice Act would strengthen penalties for companies that coerce or intimidate employees trying to form unions and bargain; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Free Choice Act would establish mediation and binding arbitration when the employer and workers cannot agree on a first contract; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Free Choice Act would enable employees to form unions when a majority signs authorization cards; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Free Choice Act makes no changes to the method of decertification which already contains the equivalent provision for when a majority of employees sign decertification cards; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Free Choice Act is supported by the majority of the Illinois Congressional delegation, including Senator Dick Durbin and President-Elect Barack Obama.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the Urbana City Council endorses the Employee Free Choice Act and
encourages the Congress to approve, and the President to sign, the Employee
Free Choice Act.
