RE:	MACC Capital Holdings (MACC) Request for Partial Street Vacation West Saline Court				

### **Introduction**

During the development of the North Lincoln Avenue Industrial Park, right-of-way was dedicated and West Saline Court was constructed short of the northern limits of the industrial park as an off-set cul-desac. Dedication of right-of-way and extension of West Saline Court to the northerly limits of the industrial park were deferred until such time as the parcels to the north of the industrial park were developed. Squire Subdivision No. 1 has been platted to the north of the industrial park necessitating the extension of West Saline Court. MACC has dedicated the necessary right-of-way to extend Saline Court to Squire Subdivision No. 1 and has requested that the cul-de-sac half circle on the east side of West Saline Court be vacated. MACC owns all of the real property on all sides of the proposed vacation.

Legal staff has reviewed the proposed vacation and has ruled that since the vacation of this small area does not affect the flow of traffic, no purpose would be served by a public hearing.

## **Recommendation**

Because the proposed vacation is determined to no longer be required by the City of Urbana for street right-of-way purposes, it is recommended that an AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WEST SALINE COURT be approved.

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#### ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WEST SALINE COURT

WHEREAS, MACC Capital Holdings, Inc. (hereinafter "MACC"), owns all of the real property on all sides of that portion of the cul-de-sac half circle on the east side of West Saline Court herein vacated; and

WHEREAS, MACC has requested such cul-de-sac be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the vacation of such cul-de-sac will not impair or affect

access to any property other than that property owned by MACC; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That the following described area of the cul-de-sac is hereby vacated, such having been determined to be no longer required by the City of Urbana for street right-of-way purposes and thus, the public interest shall be subserved by vacating the same:

part of the east  $\frac{1}{2}$  of section 31, t. 20 n., r. 9 e. of the 3<sup>RD</sup> p.m., CITY of urbana, champaign county, illinois, more particularly described as Follows:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF NORTH LINCOLN AVENUE INDUSTRIAL PARK SUBDIVISION NO. 2A, RECORDED NOVEMBER 22, 2005 AS DOCUMENT NUMBER 2005R35414 IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, SAID CORNER LYING 300.00 FEET NORMAL DISTANCE WESTERLY OF THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 31, T. 20 N., R. 9 E. OF THE 3<sup>RD</sup> P.M.; THENCE N. 00°13'21" E., (URBANA HORIZONTAL CONTROL BEARING), ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SAID SUBDIVISION NO. 2A AND EXISTING EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SALINE COURT, 235.26 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUING N. 00°13'21" E., ALONG SAID EXISTING EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE EXTENDED, 99.28 FEET TO A POINT ON SAID EXISTING EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID E

Section 2. The right-of-way herein vacated shall attach to and become a part of the parcel number identified by PIN #91-15-31-200-006.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Council hereby determines that no money compensation is appropriate because the cul-de-sac herein vacated was created as a temporary measure until West Saline Court could be extended north of the area herein vacated, and relieving the public of the need to continue to maintain the unneeded cul-de-sac is a benefit to the public.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance.

This Ordinance is herby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a three-fourth's  $(3/4^{th}'s)$  vote of the alderpersons of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
