The City is required by State law to adopt in June of each year, a schedule of prevailing wages and benefits, as provided by the Illinois Department of Labor.

This schedule is then provided to all contractors in City of Urbana public works projects and these contractors are required to pay this wage or greater to employee utilized in these public work projects.

A RESOLUTION
ASCERTAINING PREVAILING WAGES
(2009/2010)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the prevailing wages as established by the Illinois Department of Labor, Conciliation and Mediation Service for Construction Trades, dated and effective June 2009, for the County of Champaign, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved and is hereby established as prevailing wages for construction trades, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois concerning the Wages of Employees on Public Works.

Section 2. That the City Clerk shall keep available for inspection by any interested party in the City Clerk's Office this determination of the prevailing wage rate.

Section 3. That the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Resolution with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois and also the City Engineer.

Section 4. That the City Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a notice that this Resolution has been approved and is effective, and shall mail this Resolution to any person who has made a written request for the determination made herein.
