She stated that Jennifer Monson, Professor of Dance at the University of Illinois and a member of the Public Arts Commission, has started the Mahomet Aquifer Project which will have several events at various locations October $10^{\rm th}$ through the $18^{\rm th}$.

In a related matter, Mayor Prussing stated she had been contacted by Matt Varbel of Dewitt County Regional Planning Commission and President

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of Watchclintonlandfill.com about the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's consideration of a chemical waste landfill including PCB at Clinton in Dewitt County which would be located over the Mahomet Aquifer. A public hearing is being considered to discuss this issue.
