10. DISCUSSION: BROADBAND PROJECT

Chair Bowersox acknowledged public input at this time.

Peter Resnick (Chair, Broadband Access Committee), 503 W. Indiana Ave., addressed the Committee in support of the Broadband Project. Mr. Resnick informed the Committee that at its February meeting, the Broadband Access Committee (BAC) passed three motions with recommendations to city council members of the Cities of Urbana and Champaign. Those recommendations are: 1) that the Council accepts the NTIA grant funds from the Recovery Act; 2) that UC2B's charter is broadened to meet the networking goals of the community; and 3) that before engineering details are bid, both cities do an RFP (Request for Proposal) process so that options can be explored.

Chair Bowersox noted that representatives from the University of Illinois (Sharon Irish and Mike Smeltzer) were present and available to answer questions. Debate ensued.

Mr. Smyth made a motion to authorize the Mayor to reaffirm the City's support for reapplying for the UC2B Public Computer Center broadband adoption grants. Mr. Roberts seconded. The motion carried by voice vote. Debate ensued.

Mr. Smyth moved to send this item to next week's council meeting as a discussion item. Mr. Roberts seconded. The motion carried by voice vote.
