**RE:** Ordinance from Traffic Commission

Attached is an ordinance for your approval from action taken by the Urbana Traffic Commission.

The ordinance (Schedule J) prohibits parking at all times at certain locations on the east side and on the west side of Grossbach Drive and the north side of Fairlawn Drive.

Grossbach Drive is a narrow street (16 to 18 feet in width) with a turnaround that ends at Victory Park. Although the intent of the turnaround was to provide a loading area for those who use the gardens at Victory Park, other park users have been using the area for long-term parking. In addition, park users have been parking along both sides of Grossbach Drive, making access difficult. These parking restrictions would allow motorists to safely drive on the street.

Fairlawn Drive at Anderson Street is the location of a bus stop for the Champaign Urbana Mass Transit District. The current parking configuration does not allow buses to stop on Fairlawn Drive to load and unload passengers without blocking the intersection. With the parking restrictions, buses will be able to complete turn movements and stop for passengers.

The Traffic Commission has considered these locations at its June 1, 2010 meeting and recommends that the attached ordinance be passed by the City Council.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

#### (Grossbach Drive, Fairlawn Drive)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle at any time:

Street	<u>Between</u>	Side of Street
Grossbach Drive	From the centerline of Main Street to 345 feet south of the centerline of Main Street	West Side
Grossbach Drive	From 295 feet south of the centerline of Main Street to 345 feet south of the centerline of Main Street	East Side
Grossbach Drive	From the centerline of Main Street to 75 feet south of the centerline of Main Street	East Side
Fairlawn Drive	From 60 feet west of the centerline of Anderson Street to 90 feet west of the centerline of Anderson Street	North Side

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or
proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability
incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the
effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any
character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Proposed No Parking- Grossbach Drive** 


West side: from centerline of Main St. to
