Attached is a revised ordinance for your approval from action taken by the Traffic Commission at its September 7, 2010 meeting.

This revised ordinance is for the establishment of decreased speed limits on Stebbins Drive and Division Avenue. A typographical error in Section 1 of the previously submitted ordinance stated that the decreased speed limit would add the speed regulation "for a certain portion of Race Street." The attached ordinance describes the area as "certain portions of Stebbins Drive and Division Avenue."

We apologize for any confusion this may have caused.

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-10-095

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE Q OF SECTION 23-64 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE DECREASING STATE SPEED LIMITS IN CERTAIN ZONES

(Stebbins Drive, Division Avenue)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule Q of Section 23-64, entitled "Decreasing State Speed Limits in Certain Zones" of Article V of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following speed regulations for certain portions of Stebbins Drive and Division Avenue:

From the eastern terminus of Stebbins Drive to the centerline of Broadway Avenue on Stebbins Drive and from the centerline of Kerr Avenue to the centerline of Stebbins Drive on Division Avenue the speed limit shall be twenty-five miles per hour (25 MPH).

Section 2. That the Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to post the appropriate signs indicating the speed regulations set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.



This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in
pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance
shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication
in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
