Road Intersection

Join the City's Public Works staff to review the traffic signal improvements proposed for the intersection of Florida Avenue and Philo Road. Final design drawings of the proposed improvements will be available for viewing on the following project components:

- New curb bump-outs to reduce pedestrian crossing times.
- Addition of left turn signals for Florida Avenue.
- New forward looking infrared video detection system for the traffic signals that will detect both automobiles and bicyclists.
- New audible countdown push button signals for pedestrians.
- Reconfiguration of vehicular lanes to align with the road diets and bike lanes implemented on Florida Avenue and Philo Road.
- Removal of existing traffic signal equipment. Existing traffic signal equipment will be utilized as temporary signals during the installation of the new traffic signals.
