2013-2014 (HOME Program Funds)

Description

Included on the agenda of the February 10, 2014 meeting of the Committee of the Whole is an Ordinance to revise the Annual Budget Ordinance for FY 2013-2014 for the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) Funds.

Background

On June 17, 2013 Council approved Ordinance No. 2013-06-052, An Ordinance Approving the Annual Budget, which incorporated both the estimated HOME Fiscal Year 2013-2014 allocation and carryover from previous grant years. A budget amendment was later passed on October 24, 2013 via Ordinance No. 2013-10-100 to reflect the actual FY 2013-2014 grant allocation received from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the final numbers for which were received after the Annual Budget was originally approved.

The current amendment before Council provides for additional corrections to the HOME budget listed on page 122 of the *City of Urbana Budget 2013-2014*, which is provided as an attachment to this memo. The carryover funds listed on page 122 were insufficient and did not reflect the actual carryover available from previous fiscal years' allocations. The proposed budget amendment is necessary so that City staff can continue to honor contracts with subrecipients of the Urbana HOME Consortium and make timely reimbursements for program expenses.

The following table outlines the original budget approved in June, 2013, as well as the amended amounts approved by City Council on October 24, 2013. The last column details the final proposed amounts for the HOME 2013-2014 budget:

Revenues

Federal Grant – Regulatory

The proposed modifications represent a total \$1,706,327 increase to the HOME budget and are presented in three separate sections above: "Federal Grant - Reg.", "Federal Grant - Carryover", and "Program Income". The first increase is presented in the "Federal Grant - Reg." portion of the above budget. This \$318,000 increase was approved by Council on March 18, 2013 via Ordinance No. 2013-03-019, *An Ordinance Approving Modifications to the City of Urbana and Urbana HOME Consortium FY 2008-2009, FY 2010-2011, FY 2011-2012, and FY 2012-2013 Annual Action Plans*. The Amendment authorized a \$318,000 increase to the Annual Action Plans listed resulting from past fiscal years' program income receipts that had not been accounted for in the City Budget. The City Budget does not track program income receipted by the City of Champaign and Champaign County because the funds are not remitted to the City of Urbana; rather, the funds are reported to City staff on a quarterly basis. The Urbana HOME Consortium voted to allocate these funds in a lump sum to various Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) providers in the community. This \$318,000 increase was never incorporated into the FY 2012-2013 City Budget. Therefore, it must be added into the FY 2013-2014 "Federal Grant – Reg." line, as shown above.

Federal Grant - Carryover

The second portion of the increase is accounted for in the "Federal Grant – Carryover" section of the City Budget provided above. This amount was incorrectly budgeted at \$216,827 in the City Budget that was presented to Council in June, 2013. The actual carryover for the program can be found in the Budget Forecast report, which is available on the City's website. The Budget Forecast report at the end of Fiscal Year 2012-2013 indicates that the HOME Program carryover was actually \$1,581,825. This number is highlighted on the enclosed printout of Page 90/269 of the Budget Forecast (Page 90/269). The total increase attributable to carryover portion of the revision is \$1,364,827.

Program Income

The final addition to the HOME Budget is found in the "Program Income" section above. The \$24,500 estimate more accurately reflects the average amount of Program Income received in a fiscal year. Program Income is remitted to the City of Urbana when homeowners who have participated in the Whole House Rehabilitation Program sell their home. The Program is structured so that half of the project's cost is provided as a grant, and the other half is provided in the form of a deferred loan. The loan does not accrue interest but is due and payable at the time of sale transfer. This helps the City continue the Program and benefits future low-income homeowners in need of rehabilitation assistance. The original budget only accounted for \$1,000. Staff is requesting the \$23,500 increase to allow those funds to be expended as they are receipted through the fiscal year.

Expenditures

The expenditures listed above, once approved, will more accurately reflect the balance of each Consortium Member's program funds. This will improve fiscal transparency for the Urbana HOME Consortium (Consortium), as well as allow the City of Urbana, as lead entity of the Consortium, to keep all members accountable for timeliness of expenditures. More importantly, it will allow staff to continue to reimburse all subrecipients carrying out HOME Program activities in a timely manner for the remainder of the current Fiscal Year. The chart below is the HOME Program Expenditure Summary found on Page 122 of the City Budget, with the updated changes:

Fiscal Impacts

The proposed changes reflect a total \$1,706,327 increase in revenues, as well as a \$1,706,327 increase in expenditures for the Urbana HOME Consortium budget since the last amendment was approved in October, 2013. The increase will more accurately reflect the grant balance for the HOME Program and is necessary to allow staff to honor contracts with subrecipients operating various HOME Program activities.

Recommendations

Staff recommends that Council approve the proposed Ordinance, as it will give staff the authority to expend grant funds in the amount provided for Fiscal Year 2013-2014.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CITY OF URBANA and URBANA HOME CONSORTIUM FY 2011-2012 & 2012-2013 ANNUAL ACTION PLANS

The Urbana HOME Consortium proposes to amend the HOME Program budgets for the FY 2009-2010, 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 Annual Action Plans (AAPs) to re-allocate unobligated Urban HOME funds to Champaign County Neighborhood Alliance for Habitat (Neighborhood Alliance), as outlined below, for demolition of the structure at 1310 Hill Street, Urbana. Also proposed are disbursements to various social service agencies for TBRA programs currently operating in the Champaign County area. Lastly, funds from the 1304 Williamsburg CHDO homebuyer project are being reallocated to fully finance the CHDO project at 1107 N Gregory, Urbana to convert the unit to permanent, affordable rental housing. The rental unit will be operated by Community Elements, Inc.

The amendment is presented in three parts. The first proposes to re-allocate a total of \$383,805.80 in unobligated City of Champaign and Urbana HOME Consortium funds from program income to support ongoing TBRA programs in the Consortium-wide area.

The second proposal seeks to deobligate funding previously slated for the 1304 Williamsburg CHDO Homestead homebuyer project. The project will not move forward at this time due to difficulty finding a buyer. The deobligated funds will be combined with funds already invested in the 1107 N Gregory homebuyer project. A buyer has not been found for this unit for sale, and the deadline imposed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is the end of Fiscal Year 2012-2013. In order to complete the project and remain in compliance with the HOME regulations, the unit must be converted to a rental property, otherwise the funds must be returned. The funds from the 1304 Williamsburg project will be invested in the 1107 N Gregory project in order to fully finance the unit as a permanent, affordable housing unit to be operated by Community Elements, Inc. Remaining unobligated funds will be allocated as additional CHDO projects are identified in the coming fiscal year.

The third proposal is in regard to a lot slated for donation to Champaign County Neighborhood Alliance for Habitat for the construction of a single-family unit as part of the Affordable Homeownership Program using HOME funds. The City of Urbana has not yet demolished the structure currently standing on 1310 Hill Street, Urbana, and Neighborhood Alliance has agreed to carry out the demolition project using HOME CHDO funding. Because this activity was not proposed as an eligible HOME expense in the most recent FY 2012-2013 Annual Action Plan, an amendment is necessary to allocate HOME funds for this purpose. Details for each grant allocation are outlined below.

Following is proposed language for the TBRA programs to be added to each Fiscal Year's Annual Action Plan:

1. Tenant Based Rental Assistance Program. HOME funds will be used to provide affordable housing assistance to low-income residents throughout Champaign County. Assisted households will have annual incomes at or below 60% of the Area Median in accordance with HOME Regulations. The participating clients follow a team-approved plan for achieving self-sufficiency and make copayments toward rent (not to exceed 30% of the household income), based on their approved self-sufficiency plan prescribed by each respective agency operating the program. The following entities will operate Tenant Based Rental Assistance Programs, with 25 percent match required for every HOME dollar allocated:

Goal 2, Strategy 2, Activity 1 Citation - [24 CFR 92.209] Environmental – EXEMPT

Objective: Provide decent housing by creating affordable housing opportunities for households with annual incomes at or below 80% of Area Median, of which 90% will be at or below 60% of the Area Median).

Outcome: Affordability for the purpose of providing decent affordable housing. **Outcome Indicators:** Number of tenants maintaining affordable rental units at or below 60% of Area Median (est. 35).
