URBANA ARTS GRANTS PROGRAM

The Urbana Arts Grants Program is now accepting applications for the 2017 Urbana Arts Grants Program through February 6th, 2017. In addition to the \$47,500 in available funds available through the City of Urbana, the Center for Latin American and Caribbean Studies (CLACS) has pledged \$500 to support the program. OPEN SCENE

In early January, four artists will be selected to lead weekend intensives at the Independent Media Center with youth and adult participants. These weekend intensives will include arts workshops, dialogues, and public showcases, to explore a theme of social justice and/or community development through an artistic discipline. They will take place between late February and April 2017.



BIKE PLAN

The 2016 Urbana Bicycle Master Plan was adopted by Council on December 19th. The plan provides guidance for the next five years of improvements to engineering, education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation for bicycling in Urbana. The plan reaffirms City Council's goal of Vision Zero – to have zero traffic-related deaths in Urbana – and sets the stage for the City to become a Platinum-level Bicycle-Friendly Community. 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Total Square Feet Added Yearto-Date All Project Types



Single-Family and Duplex Residential Square Feet Added

Year-to-date square footage added for single and two-family new residential construction totals 81,081square feet. Square feet added for one and two family homes is at its highest in four years. The City created the Think Urbana program (the residential marketing campaign for the Enterprise Zone) to promote new lower-density residential development. Under this program new single and two family housing is expected to increase. To-date, 45 units have applied to receive Think Urbana incentives. *Source: Urbana Permit Data*

Year-To-Date Square Footage Added


All New Construction & Additions


Home Sales
