#### CLARK-LINDSEY VILLAGE

Clark-Lindsey Village held open houses for their Green House Homes throughout January. Each Green house home is designed to resemble a single-family-home and houses twelve residents



#### **BLUEBIRD BOUTIQUE**

Bluebird boutique, a womens clothing store, has signed a lease for the City owned property located Downtown at 212 W Green Street.



#### AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Construction continues on the 33-unit Highland Green project on Kerr Avenue in north Urbana. TWG Development of Indianapolis has progressed in its purchase of both the Aspen Court and Washington School properties. In a joint procurement effort, the Housing Authority of Champaign County selected Brinshore Development of Northbrook, Illinois to be the developer at the Urbana Townhomes site in east Urbana, along with other projects in the County.

## Single-Family and Duplex Residential Square Feet Added


For February, year-to-date square feet added for one and two family homes was at its highest in four years. Square footage added for single and twofamily new residential construction totaled 11,729 square feet from January through February 2017. In 2016, the City created the Think Urbana program (the residential marketing campaign for the Enterprise Zone) to promote new lower-density residential development. Under this program new single and two family housing starts are expected to increase dramatically. To-date, 48 units have applied to receive Think Urbana incentives.

### Year-To-Date Square Footage Added


All New Construction & Additions

## Year-To-Date Square Footage Added


Single and Two Family New Construction
