Updates

GATHER

Rael Development has proposed a 5-story mixed-use project on the SE corner of Lincoln and University Avenues. Gather would contain 200 apartments, 16 townhouses, and 50 extended-stay rooms, along with nearly 15,000 square feet of lobby, retail, and outdoor public areas. The project's configuration, scale and design are the product of much analysis and collaboration between the developer, the City, neighborhood feedback, and Rael's team of consultants. The project would further activate a key gateway into Urbana and the University of Illinois.

SITARA

The building permit for the repairs at 114 S. Race St. passed final inspection, and the City approved the restaurant space for occupancy in early January. The restaurant operators will be fitting out the space and completing health department inspections, hoping to open in the coming weeks.

208 W. GRIGGS

25 O'Clock Brewing has completed renovation of their taproom at 208 W. Griggs St. and is now open. C&C Kitchen has announced that they will be selling Southern inspired American cuisine at the taproom from 5:00-9:00pm. The Best of Africa Food Store also completed an expansion of their African grocery store in the same building.

LINCOLN SQUARE

Lincoln Square continued to add new businesses, with the announcement of Defy Gravity's relocation from Champaign. Defy Gravity is an aerial arts and pole dance fitness studio.



To date, 47 projects, containing a total of 231 units, have applied to receive Think Urbana incentives.




Total Square Feet Added Year-to-Date All Project Types


Year-To-Date Square Footage Added All New Construction & Additions

Year-To-Date Square Footage Added Single and Two Family New Construction




