The Best of Africa Food Store completed an expansion of their African grocery store in the same building and has submitted plans for a new event space. The new space would accommodate up to 100 people and would serve African cuisine.

PROPOSED URBANA ARTS DEVELOPMENT

In late 2018, the City was approached by Northbrook, Illinois-based Brinshore Development with a proposal for an arts-centered, affordable housing development on a city-owned parking lot south of Illinois Street, near Lincoln Square. The City and Brinshore announced in February that the project is unable to move forward due to external funding factors. Brinshore remains committed to continuing to work with the City of Urbana and the Champaign County Housing Authority to complete an affordable housing project at South Lierman Avenue in East Urbana.

ENCHANTMENT ALLEY

Enchantment Alley announced they will move to 123 W Main on March 18th. Enchantment Alley is a self-proclaimed one-stop geek superstore with movie and card game memorabilia available for sale and events center space to play. The business will provide additional family-friendly activities to Downtown Urbana.

GATHER

Rael Development has proposed a 5-story mixed-use project on the SE corner of Lincoln and University Avenues. Gather would contain 200 apartments, 16 townhouses, and 50 extended-stay rooms, along with nearly 15,000 square feet of lobby, retail, and outdoor public areas. City Council approved re-zoning of the site to B-3 as well as a Special Use Permit to construct arts, extended stay units, and retail space in February.



Total Square Feet Added Year-to-Date All Project Types

A total of 50,120 square feet were added in Urbana from January through February 2019.

With additions to the Plastic Container Corporation and new single-family home construction in Stone Creek, 2019 total square feet added became higher than in the previous three years (year-to-date).


Single-Family and Duplex Residential Square Feet Added

Year-To-Date Square Footage Added


All New Construction & Additions

Flash Index
