Approval of an emergency purchase-Boiler Replacement at the Urbana City

Building

Background:

On October 8, 2019, a boiler that provides heated water for the reheat loop in the City building failed. The boiler is one of two that accommodates the heating system for the Northwest (Community Development-Police Administration), Southwest (Police Investigations, Patrol, Services and Fire Department Administration), and first floor lobby sections of the building. Part of the failure was a cracked heat exchange that resulted in the leakage of the heated water. This happens with boilers after time, usually due to bacteria in the water corroding the metal exchange. Replacing the heat exchange on this system will result in the complete removal of the boiler to accommodate repairs. The boiler is over twenty years old and was installed and operational as part of the major renovation that took place in 1999. Parts and labor for repairs to an antiquated system rival a new replacement boiler. A&R Mechanical currently provides time and material service to the City for HVAC repairs. Their technicians have examined the system and provided pricing for replacement options.

The one functional boiler can currently maintain building set points in the mild temperatures. When consistently colder temperatures arrive within the next few weeks it is anticipated the building will not have adequate heat for occupant comfort.

Options:

1. Replace the one boiler that has currently failed at a cost of \$39,570. This presents risk as the remaining boiler is of the same age and possess the same likelihood of failure in the imminent winter months. Sourcing repair and replacement parts has proven challenging given the age and model of the current boiler. If the remaining boiler operates through the season it can be budgeted for next fiscal year.

2. Replace both boilers at a cost of \$78,750 alleviating the risk of an additional unplanned failure in cold winter months.

Proposals are attached to this memo. Upon acceptance of either, A&R can have the necessary boilers and equipment ordered and ready for installation in 3-5 days.

Community Development offices will be most impacted by the installation. Some noise and disruption can be anticipated. However, normal office operations should be able to continue through the work.

Following normal procurement policy will delay installation significantly. For that reason staff are requesting authorization of an emergency purchase.

Recommendation:

Option 2. Staff recommends alleviating the risk of an additional failure and replacing both boilers as outlined in Option 2. A&R Mechanical successfully performed a similar emergency boiler replacement at the City Building in 2012 and possess the necessary expertise to complete this project.

Fiscal Impact:

\$79,879 in currently available in the Capital Improvement Fund earmarked for emergency facility needs (City Fac. Imp. 20040470-53200-40800). If Option 2 is selected any future emergency facility capital improvements will require a budget transfer from other to be determined funds.

City of Urbana Purchasing Policy Section 4.5 Emergency Purchases states approval of this recommendation requires signature of this memorandum by the department head and Mayor. It should then be filed immediately with the Finance Director. A brief explanation including this approved memo should be placed on the agenda for the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting.
