SUBJECT:	AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE (BUDGET AMENDMENT #2 – OMNIBUS)				

Introduction: Attached is an Ordinance revising the FY2021 annual budget to provide for items described below. This budget amendment requires six affirmative votes, including the Mayor, in order to pass.

The Grants Management Division is working as the City's representative for grants. This Ordinance will amend the budget for the following grants.

On August 20, 2020, the CUPHD approved the City of Urbana work plans, scope of service, and budget to continue the Census grant through September 30, 2020. The new award will reimburse the City \$20,000 for staff time and materials to assist in those efforts.

The State of Illinois approved the City of Urbana serving as the administrator for an Emergency Solutions Grant – CV in the amount of \$188,595 to assist with homeless and shelter for low income individuals.

The unexpended Community Development Block Grant funds are being moved into the FY 2020/2021 budget. With the end of year being reconciled, moving these funds into the next fiscal year will assist in spending the funds to meet HUD's guidelines.

Fiscal Impact: The change in the General Fund is for one-time and does not have a significant fiscal impact on the General Fund.

Alternatives:

- 1. Forward the Ordinance amending the FY2021 Budget to City Council for approval
- 2. Amend one or more of the items before forwarding to Council for approval.

Recommendation: Approve the budget amendment authorizing these adjustments to the FY2021 budget for approval

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-09-046

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE

(Budget Amendment #2- Omnibus)

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana ("City") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its governmental business and affairs, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the City's home rule powers and functions as granted by the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City heretofore did approve the annual budget ordinance of and for the City of Urbana for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the said corporate authorities find that revising the annual budget ordinance by deleting, adding to, changing, or creating sub-classes within object classes and object classes themselves is in the best interests of the residents of the City and is desirable for the welfare of the City's government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, funds are available to effectuate the purpose of such revision; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Director may not may not make such revision under the authority so delegated to the Budget Director pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.6 or Urbana City Code Section 2-133.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR, BEING THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1.

The annual budget ordinance shall be and the same is hereby revised as set forth in the exhibit appended hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-2-4).

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of twothirds of the corporate authorities then holding office (6 of 8 votes) of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a duly noticed and convened meeting of the said corporate authorities.
