## Video Gaming Fees

December 17, 2021, Illinois Public Act 102-0689 amended Section 65 of the Illinois Video Gaming Act so that all municipal fees imposed on video gaming terminals must be shared equally between the terminal operator and the licensed establishment.

## New Additions continued

## Deliveries

The State Liquor Control Act was updated to permit licensees that allow off-premises consumption, or a combination of on-premises/off-premises are eligible to offer deliveries. (Class P and MB-2)

This means that Class A and R\&T licensees would have to have a Package Rider in order to allow them to offer delivery of package liquor.

## New Additions continued

## Cocktails "to Go"

Pursuant to 235 ILCS 5/6-28.8 of the Liquor Control Act
A licensee with both an on-premises and off-premises license may sell and deliver "to go" mixed drinks/cocktails and single servings of wine for off-premises consumption strictly under the conditions in the Act and City Code

Delivery by third party delivery companies is not permitted
Class A, R\&T, and MB-2 licensees are eligible, however, A and R\&T will need a Package Rider
State expiration on January 3, 2024 unless extended
